## FAQs

**Vaccination4Life** is a lifetime vaccination plan where a one-off payment will provide your pet with annual boosters and annual health checks for the rest of their life. There are no hidden costs. You simply make a one-off payment and you can rest easy knowing your pet will be protected for the duration of their life.

### Annual vaccinations and health checks for life, just \$450

We created **Vaccination4Life** because so many people stop vaccinating their pets mid way through their life. As a result, we still see many infections in puppies and kittens that could be prevented. Most of these diseases, like parvovirus, tragically kill many pets each year.

Vaccinations and annual boosters protect your pet from painful and fatal diseases.

#### WHAT VACCINES ARE INCLUDED?

- C5 Vaccine for Dogs including; Canine Distemper Virus, Infectious Canine Hepatitis, Canine Parvovirus, Canine Parainfluenza and Bordetella Bronchiseptica (Canine Cough or otherwise known as Kennel Cough).
- F4 or F3 Vaccine for Cats at the Veterinarian's and Owner's discretion; Feline Rhinotracheitis Virus, Calicivirus, Panleucopenia Virus and Chlamydia Psittaci (not included in the F3 combination).

#### IS FIV INCLUDED?

FIV can be included for an extra \$100 cost.

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR VACCINATION4LIFE?

For this program to be financially beneficial we recommend all pets under 7 years of age are eligible for **Vaccination4Life**.

#### Terms and Conditions:

- **Vaccination4Life** can be purchased prior to vaccination.
- Payment cannot be made in installments and must be completed at time of vaccination.
- Pets must be microchipped as part of this program.
- Core Vaccines are included as per the program. For Cats this is the F3 or F4 vaccine and for Dogs this is the C5 vaccine, which includes Kennel Cough. Rabies vaccine is not included and nor is FIV & FeLV Vaccine.
- Vaccines will be given in the frequency as directed by the World Small Animal Veterinary Association Guidelines.
- If a pet is deemed too sick for a vaccination by the Veterinarian then a consultation fee may be charged and treatment may be prescribed. These will incur a separate cost. In such a case, the Vaccination will be postponed to a date following the pets recovery.
