

A few facts you need to know

The **WellnessProgram** provides an all-inclusive list of preventative healthcare treatments and services to members for a small fee of \$49.95 per month, with an upfront fee of \$90.00, which will be direct debited from your account. It's a hassle free and no stress program designed to benefit the health of your pet.

Our **WellnessProgram** ensures your pet lives a healthy and happy life by making looking after your pet simple and affordable.

What is the **WellnessProgram**?

Becoming a member of the **WellnessProgram** will allow your pet to receive preventative healthcare treatments and services at no extra cost.

This includes:

- Annual Vaccinations
- Unlimited sick pet consultations
- Micro-chipping
- Nurse Nail Clips
- Nurse dental checks
- Nurse Anal Gland Expression
- Annual Diagnostic Blood tests
- Annual Diagnostic Urine tests
- \$150 Dental Discount for Scale and Polish (per annum)

Is the **Wellness program** Like Insurance?

No. It is important to note that this is not an insurance policy. Most insurance policies are designed for when pets become unwell, or have accidents and injuries. They don't cover the preventative health issues that the **Wellness Program** covers.

We recommend combining the **Wellness Program** with Pet Insurance for total peace of mind.

You can receive preventative health care and services all year long for **\$49.95** a month.

What are the Terms and Conditions?

- Every pet participating in the program will need to have a working microchip. This will be done if your pet does not have one already
- Core vaccines are included for this program. For Cats this is F3, and for dogs this is C3 & C5. Puppy vaccines are included if applicable to pet.
- Vaccines will be given in the frequency as directed by the World Small Animal Veterinary Association Guidelines.
- Additional fees apply for extended consults.
- Medication and treatment costs are charged as normal.
- All consultations or vaccinations are offered by appointment only.
- A \$40 no-show fee will be charged to clients who do not show up for a scheduled appointment.
- If a pet passes away, it is the responsibility of the owner to contact the direct debit company to cancel the policy. There may be a delay of one month when canceling a policy.
- Blood tests include either Pre-GA or comprehensive with CBC. This is at the discretion of the vet.
- There may be a waiting period of 6 months before your pet can access the blood testing.
- Fee may be subject to a once yearly rise no more than the rate of inflation. Any price changes will be communicated before being implemented.
- Dental discounts cannot be used in conjunction with any other discounts.

This program ensures your pet will remain healthy and happy and provide you with peace of mind.
